
Dear Mr. Read:

Payment of the Falk Foundation's grant to the Foundation for Economic Education, Inc. for the study of industry-wide collective bargaining by Dr. Wolman will be made before the end of this month.

The Falk Foundation requires that recipients of its research grants print the following statement in all publications reporting the studies made under these research grants: "This study was made possible by funds granted by The Maurice and Laura Falk Foundation of Pittsburgh. The Foundation, however, is not the author, publisher, or proprietor of the study and is not to be understood, by virtue of its grant, as assuming responsibility for any statement or view expressed herein." This statement is usually made a part of the foreword or preface.

Although it is not a requirement, the Falk Foundation hopes that each recipient of its research grants will be willing to send a copy of the study reporting the research investigation to some 500 persons with the compliments of a member of the Board of the Falk Foundation. Very shortly I shall send you the names of the persons constituting the complimentary list of each of our Board members. In mailing the study you should insert a printed card reading something like this: "With the compliments of _____"
(inserting the name of the proper member of the Foundation's Board).
