I think there was no concern or problem about the use of the "United Nations" term by Mises in 1947, since it would have been well known then that this referred to the 1942 agreement between 26 nations then at war against the Axis Powers (See Beard, Charles A. & Mary R., A Basic History of the United States, New Home Library edition, 1944, p. 481). You're probably right that this should be explained when and if we do a new printing. Thanks for calling it to our attention.
