RE Opitz' The Lengthening Shadow of Government

Seems to me that, in view<sup>of</sup> the many months that have elapsed since the condensation of this article was published in Faith and Freedom, that instead of calling the original article a "condensation," it might be preferable to call this an "elaboration" of the thesis first explored in a short article in F & F, May, 1953. ~~1954~~

Page 7: 2nd sentence. This is not of course limited to republican forms of government, it might be called "democratic," "representative," etc. My thought is that a broader adjective ~~could~~ be used here. No

Page 12: bottom line. This is such an important thought, the transition from the first half of the article about the "lengthening shadow" to the second half which talks about the proper sphere of government, that it seems it should be set apart somehow by a Head, or dark print or underline. No
