1. At the end of each chapter in the Study Guide following the list of references, the asterisk (*) is inadequately identified as "FEE Publications." Please change this identification to read: Publications of the Foundation for Economic Education, Irvington-on-Hudson, New York. The pages involved are 125, 128, 134, 135, 143, 146, 150, 157, 167.
2. On page 133, third line from bottom, the reference should be page 70, rather than pages 38-39.
3. On page 146, seventh line from top, the article "On Academic Freedom," is by William Chamberlain, rather than a second place by William Henry Chamberlin.
4. In the References on pages 124-125, please add:
ALRIGHT, WILLIAM F. The Judeo-Christian View of Man, in Man's Right to Knowledge, First Series.

I trust that these changes can be handled without too great difficulty.

Finally, unless it is mechanically too difficult, could the author's name and the title of the book be printed on the spine of the cover for the paper-backed copies?

We appreciate your cooperation in helping us bring this book to public attention.
