To confirm this morning's telephone conversation, please proceed with the printing of Musatti's "Constitution" book. The number to be printed will be 4,000 paper-bound and 1,000 clothbound to be delivered to FEE at Irvington, plus the quantity of clothbound wanted by D. Van Nostrand. My understanding is that they want 1,000 copies, but that you will check with them before giving the print order. If that is the right quantity, the total printing now would be 6,000 copies -- 2,000 clothbound and 4,000 paper-bound.

These will bear a 1956 printing date.

It is my further understanding that, after this printing, plates are to be held by the printer subject to instructions from D. Van Nostrand for further printing.

Also, please check with D. Van Nostrand as to their price and discount schedule for clothbound copies, to which FEE is to conform on future sales of the clothbound edition. I understand that we will hold to the price of \$2.00 already quoted for the paper-bound volumes.
