I am returning the page proofs. They gave me a lot of trouble, as the typographer did not follow my paging, and gave me pages of unequal depth. I have doctored it up, so that all the pages are 31 lines long. This will mean additional setting that should have been avoided. Most of the corrections on the original galley, were to make the pages come out even, which was not followed. Will you send another set of page proofs -- two will be ample -- but do not hold up the job in any way. Dean will phone you, if everything is done as I have ordered this time.

Will you please also return to us as soon as you can Dean's original copy, as he is planning to use that for his speech. He wants to read from the original manuscript instead of from a carbon copy.

I am also enclosing the cover proof on Bargaining.
