Dear Lillian:

I have put you and Robert's name on a list to receive information about a one-day conference on Christianity and economics to be held in Lynchburg, VA on Friday, April 7. If one or both of you are interested and free, I'm sure you'll find it a worthwhile experience. I've been told that James Gwartney will be there to give a paper; Michael Novak has been invited (acceptance indefinite yet). I'm supposed to make a presentation or two; Herb Schlossberg will speak, if he can clear up a conflict in his schedule, etc. The official program will finalize everything when it arrives within a month (?).

But my real reason for this letter concerns a smaller, by invitation only, dinner meeting that is being planned for the evening before (April 6). You expressed an interest in knowing more about the Villars Project. What I'm trying to set up for the Thursday night dinner meeting is a select group of no more than 20 people connected with our Villars project, FEE, and people in the economics department at Liberty University who are also interested in improving economic literacy among Christian clergy and lay people. The purpose of the meeting is to explore ways in which the related interests of these different groups might lead to forms of cooperation-- for example, through the distribution of television tapes, audio tapes, etc. Liberty University has marvellous media facilities along with their extension programs that earn both college and seminary credits.

I have enclosed a copy of the Villars Platform that appears at the end of the Crossway book (FREEDOM, JUSTICE AND HOPE) that you should have received several months ago.

I imagine that the program for the April 7 conference will arrive addressed to Mr. and Mrs. Robert Love. But arrangements for the smaller dinner meeting the night before will be separate. If you and Bob are interested in coming, just let me know and I'll carry on with the business of keeping you posted on the April 6 meeting. I'm going to do my best to get Bruce Evans there.
