An "updated and much-expanded" edition of Greaves's earlier bibliographies *The Works of Ludwig von Mises* (1962, 1969). This new bibliography is indeed much more extensive than its predecessors, which numbered less than 75 pages. The first section of the volume is a record of all books and monographs written by Von Mises. The second is a listing of his articles, addresses, and reviews. The sections are arranged chronologically. Each entry in these two sections includes bibliographic information for the original work, reprints, other editions, and translations of the work. The next major section is a listing of reviews of books written by Von Mises. The entries in this section include the citation for the review and excerpts from the review or in some cases the complete review. The final major section is a chronological listing of books and articles about Von Mises. The annotations throughout the bibliography are very useful and range in length from a sentence or two to several paragraphs. There is a good author/title index. Highly recommended for upper-division undergraduates, graduate students, and faculty.—D. G. Ernsthausen, Wake Forest University
