We are preparing a manuscript entitled "Liberty: A Path to its Recovery." We plan to print it in accordance with the following specifications:

Cover:	65# Strathmore, printed in two colors by offset.

The book should be flush trimmed.

Text:

The book will run 160 pages, and we want to print it on 60# Quality text, the same as that used in the enclosed copy of "Industry-Wide Bargaining." The book should be run from type. Page depth will be 40 picas. The body will be on 11/15 Electra on a 25 pica measure. All the display matter will be Electra.

Folios:	14 pt. figures
Running heads:	14 pt. small caps
Quoted matter:	9/12 Electra
Footnotes:	8/10
Chapter heads:	14 pt. caps letterspaced 1 pt.
Chapters and Numbers:	9 pt. Italic caps.

There will be one half-page chart for which we will supply the finished art.
