Dear Grace:

Here is the marked-up copy for the new printing of "The Bill of Rights." I think it's pretty clear, but if there is any question please phone me. It might be well to do that anyway in order that we may go over it together.

There are a few points that I didn't indicate on the copy:

1. The first page of the text should be raised in order to keep it the same page depth as the rest of the booklet.
2. We would like to use a larger size type in this printing -- perhaps 11/13 Granjon instead of 10/12.
3. We would like to use just the one color throughout.
4. The "Bill of Rights" itself should remain on pages 10 and 11 as it now stands.

I'd appreciate seeing page proofs on this before the job goes to press.
