

America in miniature

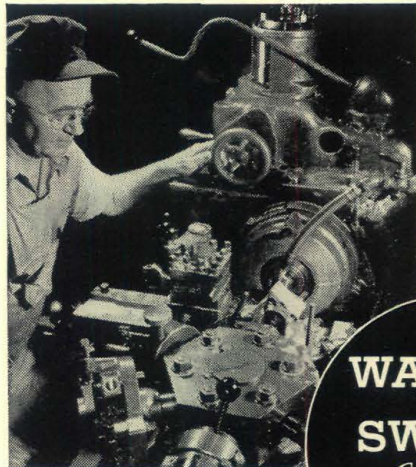

If tax laws let them keep enough of their hard-earned profits to grow on. *If* the workers they hire

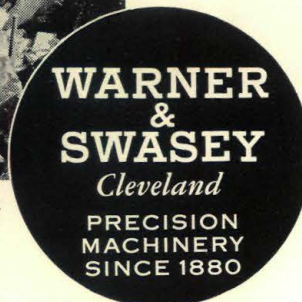
