Less production for the same high pay of course increases costs and prices, and that means fewer people will buy, fewer workers will be needed.

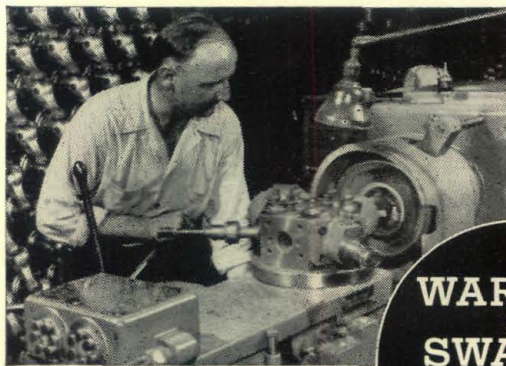
With fewer jobs, the same cry goes up
