"But, you have never asked me for money! I give plenty to organizations I think less of than FEE."

So general is the practice of importuning for funds that when an institution desists — as does FEE — the impression gets abroad that it has no use for funds. Be that as it may, we insist on living by the freedom-of-choice philosophy we espouse and, thus, will continue to cut back or expand our educational activities as *donor-initiated* funds decline or rise. <u>You</u> do the choosing!
