The Foundation for Economic Education, Inc. (FEE), of Irvington, New York, has announced an October 23, 1995 release date for a new edition of its house bestseller, *Criminal Justice? The Legal System Versus Individual Responsibility*.

The book, to be released in hardcover, will feature a new Foreword by John Walsh, host of "America's Most Wanted" (Fox Television Network). Extensive promotion is planned, to include direct mail, trade/consumer advertising, an author tour and media appearances.

Edited by Robert James Bidinotto, an award-winning investigative journalist for Reader's Digest, *Criminal Justice?* compiles work by prominent experts on crime, criminals and the law, and proposes controversial justice system reforms.

The book was released solely to FEE's traditional mail-order and niche markets in 1994. It was immediately hailed by judges, law enforcement officials and victims' rights advocates as the definitive statement of the causes and cures for crime. A national police organization distributed *Criminal Justice?* to every member of the 104th Congress.

The unexpected response has prompted FEE — a non-profit educational foundation established in 1946 — to issue a completely redesigned edition for the trade. The book will be distributed by Associated Publishers Group of Nashville (800) 327-5113.
