The original book that I have that contains "The Law" which the Pamphleteers used in their first copy does not give the name of the translator. The publishers were W. & F. G. Cash, Bishopsgate Without, London. The date of the publication was 1853. If the firm is still in business, possibly you could get the translator by writing to the publisher. The book is called "Essays on Political Economy," by the late M. Frederic Bastiat, Member of the Institute of France." It is in four parts: part one, Capital and Interest; part two, That which is seen, and that which is not seen; part three, Government, What is Money?; part four, The Law.
