The Law

p. 49 (p. 374), line 3: Think less of punishing faults and more of ~~the~~ encouraging the virtues of which you have need.

p. 51 (p. 376) line 4: Their error was that they -- with an incredibly ~~lot~~ of uncritical view, and on top of that with a childish conventionality -- admitted that which is inadmissible: the grandeur, etc; etc.

p. 65 (p. 387 (1/2)) line 4th from below: In giving the ~~ship building~~ ^{maritime} industries its protection in exchange for their liberty, ~~the~~ ^{the govt;} ~~it~~ ^{she} undertakes to make ~~the~~ ^{them} profitable; if they are ~~a~~ ^{some} burden whose fault is it?

naval, nautical = maritime
armament, equipment = armament
