
Dear Henry:

I always follow your column, and I wish we could get together again some time.

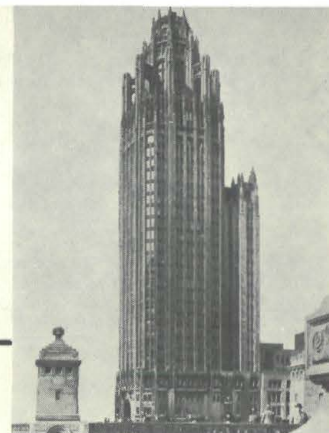


