Permit me to express my appreciation of "The Salaries of Congress" appearing in News Week. This is the most informative and, in my opinion, penetrating discussion of the matter I have seen. Particularly have you emphasized the important issue.

You might be interested to know that the Colorado State Constitution by two provisions (Secs. 6 and 9 of Article V) prohibits the members of the State General Assembly from making any increase in salaries of that position applicable to the current members of the legislature. I imagine that a search of other State Constitutions would show similar provisions.
