

Summer Seminar in Economics Slated in Tokyo July 22-Aug. 1

A summer seminar in economics will be held in Tokyo from July 22 to Aug. 1, inclusive, at Waseda University, under the joint sponsorship of Waseda University (graduate school of business), the United States Educational Commission in Japan (Fulbright Commission) and the exchange of persons branch of the American Embassy, it was announced here yesterday.

About 45 economists representing Japanese universities, government and business will come to Tokyo from all parts of Japan to hear lectures and to participate in discussions dealing with the American economy.

Lecturers and discussion leaders will include an American economist especially invited from the United States to attend this seminar, American Fulbright guest professors of economics already in Japan, and Japanese economists.

Proceedings will be conducted in the English language with interpreters when necessary.

This year's seminar theme is "Current Economic Trends in the United States and Their Meaning for Japan."

The general chairman of the seminar is Prof. Koichi Shimada, chairman of the Graduate School of Business Administra-

tion, Waseda University.

Discussion group topics and leaders are as follows: *157*

1. Fiscal and Monetary policies: Prof. William E. Dunkman, chairman of the Department of economics at the University of Rochester and visiting Fulbright lecturer in economics at Tohoku University, and Prof. Masatoshi Nakauchi, lecturer in international finance at Waseda University.

2. International Trade: Prof. Edward E. Pratt, professor of foreign trade at New York University and visiting Fulbright lecturer in international trade at Waseda University, and Prof. Shoshin Nakashima, dean of the school of commerce and professor of international economics at Waseda University.

3. Economic Developments in Agriculture: Prof. Floy L. Underwood, professor of agricultural economics at Oklahoma A. & M. College and visiting Fulbright lecturer in agricultural economics at Hokkaido University, and Prof. Takeshi Yajima, chairman of the department of agricultural economics and professor of agricultural economics at Hokkaido University.
